**Nightline** – Use goggles to blindfold your partner and lead them through an obstacle course



**Gutterball** – The first player holds a plastic gutter with a ball in it. Play by passing the ball from one person's gutter to the next. When you no longer hold the ball, run to collect it into your gutter from the player who does have it.



**Lego Challenge** – This game is for 3 people to play. Player 1 designs and builds a structure using the bricks. Player 2 has to describe to player 3 how to build it.



**Pin Board Game** – For two people, one to give directions, the other to follow the directions and put the string on the nails. When finished it will form a picture.



**Frisbee Golf** – How many throws to get to the target from different starting points.

**Rat Run** – Teams race to see who is first to get their wooden rat to the other end of the rope.
