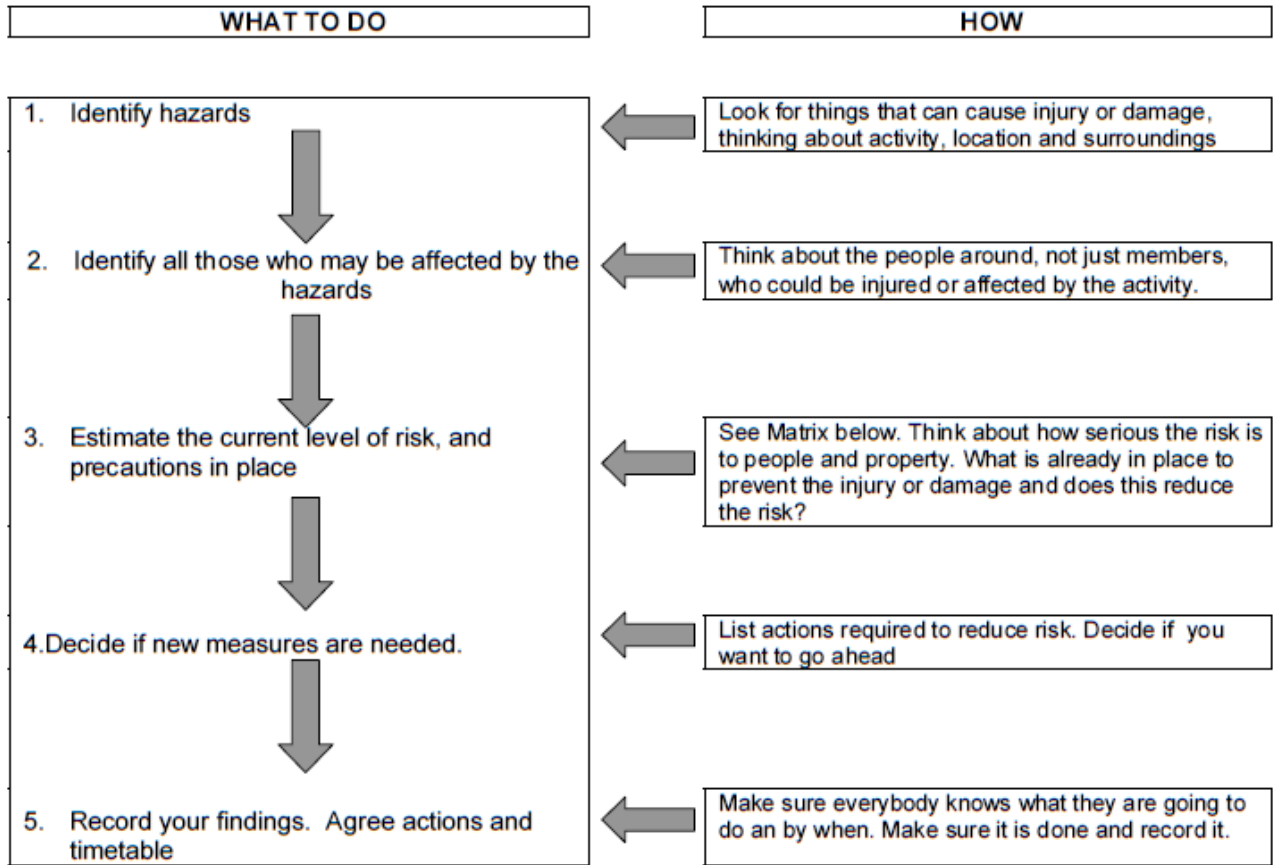

| Trips and Falls | Participants | Ensure all participants are wearing suitable clothing (nothing in pockets) and appropriate footwear Check ground conditions for holes, lumps, other obstacles | L | No | | |
